

AVERAGE INCOME WALK

Requirements of this activity:

- (I) 6 volunteers
- (2) Floor marked PROPORTIONATELY e.g. each I foot = \$10,000; suggestion: for \$0 \$150,000 mark every \$10,000; then mark \$300,000 and \$1,125,000
- (3) I2 envelopes labeled by quintile and by year with instructions for each year in separate envelopes each volunteer gets both the 1979 & the 2006 envelope for his/her quintile

1979 Income Walk

You are Quintile #I – the lowest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: please walk to the \$10,369 income level (2006 \$)

You are Quintile #2 – the second 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: please walk \$25,790 income level (2006 \$)

You are Quintile #3 – the middle 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: please walk to the \$42,520 income level (2006 \$)

You are Quintile #4 – the second highest 20% of all households by income (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: please walk to the \$62,398 income level (2006 \$)

You are the top Quintile – the highest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: please walk to the \$111,892 income level (2006 \$)

You are the top 1% of all families by <u>income</u> (approx 810,000 households)

1979: please walk to the \$314,000 income level (2006 \$)

2006 Income Walk

You are Quintile #I – the lowest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: please move to the \$11,352 income level – how does this compare to where you walked to in 1979?

You are Quintile #2 – the second 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: please move to the \$28,777 income level – how does this compare with where you walked to in 1979?

You are Quintile #3 – the middle 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: please move to the \$48,223 income level – how does this compare with where you walked to in 1979?

You are Quintile #4 – the second highest 20% of all households by income (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: please walk to the \$76.329 income level – how does this compare with where you walked to in 1979?

You are the top Quintile – the highest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: please walk to the \$168,170 income level – how does this compare with where you walked to in 1979?

You are the top 1% of all households by <u>income</u> (approx 1,125,000 households)

2006: please walk to the \$1,124,297 income level – how does this compare with where you walked to in 1979?
