

INCOME SHARES WALK

Requirements of this activity:

- (I) 6 volunteers
- (2) Floor marked PROPORTIONATELY e.g. each I foot = 2% of total income; suggestion: for 0 20% mark every 2%, above 20% mark every 5% up to 55%
- (3) I2 envelopes labeled by quintile and by year with instructions for each year in separate envelopes each volunteer gets both the 1979 & the 2006 envelope for his/her quintile

1979 Income Share Walk

You are Quintile #I – the lowest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> share (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: you received 4.1% of total US household income - please walk to the appropriate marker

You are Quintile #2 – the second lowest 20% of all households by income share (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: you received 10.2% of total US household income - please walk to the appropriate marker

You are Quintile #3 – the middle 20% of all households by <u>income</u> share (approx 16.2 million households))

1979: you received 16.8% of total US household income - please walk to the appropriate marker

You are Quintile #4 – the second highest 20% of all households by income share (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: you received 24.6% of total US household income - please walk to the appropriate marker

You are the top Quintile – the highest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> share (approx 16.2 million households)

1979: you received 44.2% of total US household income - please walk to the appropriate marker

You are the top 1% of all families by <u>income share</u> (approx 810,000 households)

1979: you received 6.2% of total US household income - please walk to the appropriate marker and take your share from the top quintile

2006 Income Share Walk

You are Quintile #I – the lowest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> share (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: you received 3.9% of total US household income - please step back to the appropriate marker

You are Quintile #2 – the second lowest 20% of all households by income share (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: you received 8.4% of total US household income - please step back to the appropriate marker

You are Quintile #3 – the middle 20% of all households by <u>income</u> share (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: you received 13.2% of total US household income - please step back to the appropriate marker

You are Quintile #4 – the second highest 20% of all households by income share income (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: you received 19.5% of total US household income - please step back to the appropriate marker

You are the top Quintile – the highest 20% of all households by <u>income</u> share (approx 22.5 million households)

2006: you received 55.7% of total US household income - please step ahead to the appropriate marker

You are the top 1% of all families by <u>income share</u> (approx 1,125,000 households)

2006: you received 18.8 of total US household income - please step ahead to the appropriate marker — and take your share from the top quintile
